Care Plans

All boarding plans have been designed to remove worry of your horse's care and free up time for you to enjoy your equine friend. Shuva Stables is focused on optimal care for your horse using natural and proven rotational plans supplemented with health-focused feeds and supplements. All boarding packages are designed to be semi-full care.

IMPORTANT: Shuva Stables is a sweet feed free boarding facility, no exceptions. Owner feeds chosen will need to be low sugar/starch unless otherwise advised by a vet. Keep open lines of communication with stable management. Sharing information about your horse's habits, preferences, and any health concerns fosters a supportive community.

Shuva Stables reserves the right to adjust prices based on feed, hay, and overall price fluctuations that occur. Owners will be provided with a 60-day notice on any price changes that occur.

Forage Based Basic Care: At Shuva Stables, we prioritize the well-being of your horses by offering tailored feeding programs that include a balanced mix of high-quality clean beet pulp pellets, alfalfa pellets, and/or timothy pellets and a Vermont Blend balancer. Our pricing is based on the precise feed weights required to maintain each horse, allowing for flexibility in accommodating your preferences. If the estimated feed weights for a horse's program differ from actual usage, we provide owners with a credit adjustment quarterly to ensure fairness and transparency in our billing process.

Additional Supplements: Shuva Stables will drop 1 liquid supplement and 1 additional dry supplement supplied by the owner per feed for each horse. Any additional dry supplements Owner will be required to order from SmartPak or premeasure and bag supplements. **If the provided supplement requires a special measurement (like a TBSP, ¼ TSP, etc), Owner will supply the required measuring tool.**

Annual Mandatory

The following prices will be considered mandatory for all horses. All boarders will be provided adequate heads up prior.

Blankets	\$25/month	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • November through -March

		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Blankets are put on at night if temperatures fall below 40 degrees. This is at the barn manager's discretion – specific horse needs will be evaluated case-by-case. All blankets are removed at AM feed. A turn out sheet can be applied if temperature/weather requires.
Grooming	\$30/month	3 times/week - Basic grooming includes curry comb/brush body, brush and care for mane and tail. Pick feet.
Medicine Application	\$1/application – please see note	Price depends on the level of care required and complexity/frequency needed.
Exercise	\$60/month	3 – 20 min sessions a week. Includes light lunging, stretching, or walking on trails, basic groundwork. No riding.
Stall Rest	\$30/week	Horses that require stall rest (vet request only)
Vet Hold	\$30/hold	Request 1 week heads up
Additional Fly Spray Application	\$15/month	Evening fly spray application (AM included with care package) - Owner provides fly spray.
